### 1st Day

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SCHEDULE 9:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.

9.30am Welcome and presentation.

10.00-12.00h Nursing Techniques in simulation room D:

Peripheral venous line cannulation (low fidelity simulation)

- Video to review knowledge prior to practice.
- All students will individually practice peripheral venous line cannulation using simulation arms.

12:00-12:30h Rest.

12:30-2:30 p.m. Nursing Techniques in simulation room D:

Measurement and assessment of vital signs and dressing workshop

- All students will perform in pairs the measurement and assessment of vital signs (blood pressure, pulse, temperature and oxygen saturation) and bandaging techniques on the upper extremity with an elastic bandage.

### 2nd Day

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9:30-11:30 a.m. Clinical case of a patient with acute respiratory distress using high-fidelity simulation "SimMan 3G".

- First we will explain how the SimMan 3G simulator works and the material that you will have to use to carry out the clinical case.
- We will give them the clinical case so that they can read the patient's information and the instructions that the doctor has given.
- In groups of 2 or 3 people they will carry out the clinical case.

11:30 a.m. Rest.

12.00-12.30h Visit to the Anatomical Museum of Valladolid.

12:30-2:30 p.m. Visit to the University Clinical Hospital.

During the practices that will be carried out (both days) the students will learn to prepare all the necessary material for the different techniques, we will explain all the specific vocabulary for each of them. They will practice therapeutic communication with the patient by identifying and presenting the patient and explaining all the procedures that will be performed in each situation. They will also have to practice communication with their colleagues and teamwork.
